

End of the Year First in Flight ASC ASCA Agility Awards for 2014 Rules and Regulations

Open to ALL who compete in the FIFASC Agility Trials

Requirements: Your dog must compete in at least one of the FIFASC ASCA agility trials for 2014. Your dog must either have an ASCA registration or ASCA tracking number. Only ASCA agility trials hosted by FIFASC will count toward the end of year Award. The forms will be available on the club website or you can pick them up at the trials. You must send the completed End of Year Agility Awards Form (one for each trial) via snail mail or email to the following address:

Completed forms must be received by **January 1, 2015**.

They will then be verified against the reports sent to ASCA for that trial.

There will be first, second, third and fourth awarded for Australian Shepherds and first, second, third and fourth awarded for Honorary Aussies (Other Breeds including Mixed breed) at the end of the year. These awards will **NOT** be broken down by Novice, Open and Elite as you can change levels during the year. The award for 2014 will be awarded at our March 2015 ASCA agility trial. Points will count from the following FIFASC ASCA agility trials for 2014: March 29-30, June 27-29 and November 22-23.

How the awards will be determined:

Points will be awarded for both placements and qualifying runs. If you earn a 1st place and it is a qualifying run you will receive the points for both the placement and the qualification.

Please note that the points are different between a 10 and a 5 point Qualification in Regular.

1stPlace– 5 points

2ndPlace– 4 points

3rdPlace– 3 points

4thPlace– 2 points

10 point Qualification– 5 points

5 point Qualification– 3 points

Remember, you can place in your class in ASCA even if you don't qualify, so even if you don't have a high qualifying rate, you could still have a good number of overall points.

The results will be reviewed by the Officers and Board of Directors of FIFASC prior to awarding of Prizes.
